## Arrival and Departure

There are many ways to get to the Theater im Ballsaal. We recommend that you travel by public transport or by bicycle - and not only because these options are more environmentally friendly than traveling by car. Parking spaces in Endenich are a rarity and in most cases already occupied by residents or visitors of the surrounding gastronomy. You can easily take the bus to our front door and you can chain your bicycle to the iron bars at the nearby Volksbank or Harmonie.
